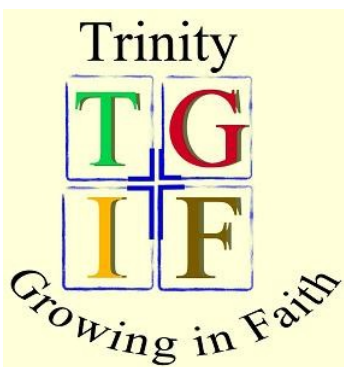
Psalm 9:1 – “I will praise you, Lord, with all my heart and tell about the wonders you have worked.”
